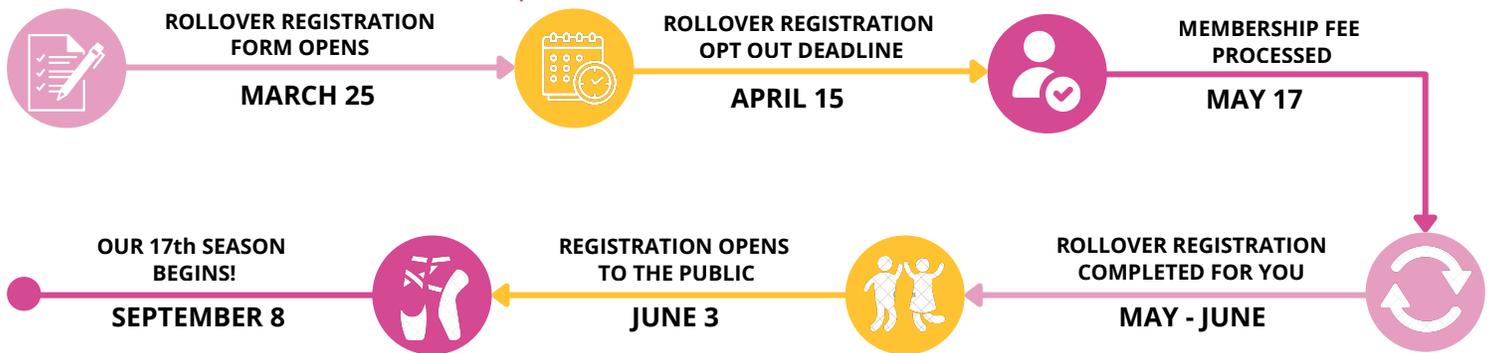


Your Next Steps

Rollover Registration Form Opens

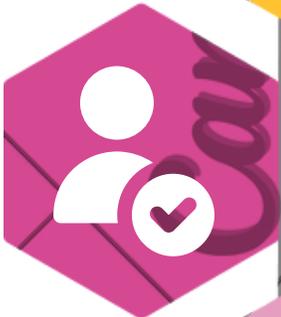

Opt out deadline

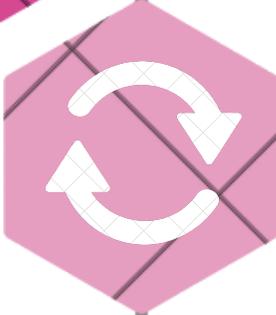
If you wish to opt out of Rollover Registration, complete our form by April 14th. You can also opt out of specific styles using the form. You can always choose to register later this summer or in the fall by emailing us at info@elevationdancestudio.com or through the parent portal, but space will not be guaranteed.



MAY 17

Next year's Membership fee processed

Your annual membership fee will be processed on May 17th. With Rollover Registration, your membership fee will be locked in \$90. Membership benefits will be published in the summer.



MAY - JUNE

Rollover Registration completed for you

All current dancers will automatically be registered into their new classes and therefore guaranteed a space. Tuition will be processed for the 1st month's tuition on August 15th. If your dancer wants to add a new class in addition to what they have already been placed in, you can simply login to your parent portal and add this class at any time after May 17th OR send us an email and we'll register your dancer for you!

JUNE 3

Registration opens to the public

Any dancers who opted out of Rollover Registration and any new dancers will be able to register for our next season.

Rollover Registration Information



Please make sure you read the information regarding our categories of classes. Dancers ages 3-10 will be recommended for the Elevation class(es) that correspond with the age he/she will be as of September 1st. Dancers are placed in classes according to both level and age at the Junior, JII, Teen and Senior levels.



Please note that dancers may spend **two or more years** in a level before mastering all of the skills necessary for the next level. Also this placement is based on a snapshot in time. Summer classes and workshops are a great way to improve and keep dancers conditioned before next season.



Recommendations are made based upon a variety of factors including age, progress the entire year, dress code, attitude, and attendance. Teachers work hard to make sure that all individual placements lead to classroom groupings that will work well together in the coming season.

Every dancer's journey is completely unique – your dancer may progress at a different rate as their classmates. What is most important to us is placing your child in a position where they are challenged, but not overwhelmed, and set up for success!

How Many Classes Should My Dancer Take?

Which Style Of Class Should I Choose?



Take TAP if you like *rhythms and sounds*

Tap develops a strong sense of rhythm, coordination and agility by creating sounds with the feet.



Take BALLET if you like feeling *elegant and poised*

Ballet develops discipline and technique that is essential to all forms of dance, as well as proper posture, placement, alignment.



Take JAZZ if you like to *move and groove*

Jazz is stylized dancing that is energetic and fun. It focuses on developing proper technique, flexibility, leaps and turns.



Take CONTEMPORARY if you like to dance from your *soul*

Contemporary combines the technical elements of dance with feelings and emotions. It tells a story through movement.



Take HIP HOP if you like *trendy music and dances*

Hip Hop is a freestyle form of dance that stems from the roots of jazz, but incorporates modern urban movements and is performed to modern music.

Apply and/or audition to be a part of The Nutcracker, our Performance Company Program and/or our Competition Teams and focus on connecting with a live audience and the skills for stage.



Frequently Asked Questions

What if my child wants to begin a style they have never done before?

Great! We encourage students to try other dance styles. They all vary so much, from technique, to music, to style, that your dancer may have a wide variety of classes they enjoy. If you aren't sure what level, let us know and we will recommend the best place for your child.

What if I question my child's class placement?

It is important that you trust us to help make the correct decision for your dancer. Our teachers have years of experience and ensure that dancers are placed in the best possible class for their developmental level, ability, and age. We are happy to answer questions through email or you can set up a meeting with our director. Any changes to level placements will be done after the first few weeks of classes when we assess all students at the beginning of the fall season.
