SIGNAGE:

X Signage has been posted at each entrance of the facility or location to inform all employees and customers that they must

- avoid entering the facility or location if they have a cough or fever (or any other symptoms);
- maintain a minimum six-foot distance from one another;
- sneeze and cough into a cloth or tissue or, if not available, into one's elbow;
- not shake hands or engage in any unnecessary physical contact;
- frequently wash their hands;
- and cover their nose and mouth with a non-medical, cloth face-covering.

Signage has been posted with a copy of the Mitigation Protocol at each entrance to the facility or at a visible location for both employees and guests/patrons.

MEASURES TO PROTECT EMPLOYEE HEALTH:

Everyone who can carry out their work duties from home has been directed to do so (**even if business is deemed critical/essential**).

All employees have been told not to come to work if sick (including any of the following- headache, sore throat, fever, dry cough, recent inability to taste and smell, shortness of breath, ear aches, body aches, diarrhea, fatigue, vomiting and abdominal pain).

Employee(s) shall self-screen for COVID-19 symptoms each day, including measuring the employee's temperature. The employee is asked to sign a record that the symptom check was completed. Any employee that exhibits COVID-19 symptoms must be excluded from work. Employee is directed to symptom screen here: <https://symptomsupport.covid19.colorado.gov/intake-form>

All desks, individual work stations or work areas are separated by at least six feet.

Break rooms, bathrooms, and other common areas, and other high-touch surfaces are being disinfected frequently, on the following schedule:

Break rooms: NOT CURRENTLY OPEN

Bathrooms: AFTER EACH USE & DEEP CLEAN 4-5X / WEEK, SHOWERS CLOSED

Other: CLASSROOM / STUDIO FLOORS ARE DISINFECTED AND STUDIO HIGH TOUCH SURFACES ARE WIPED DOWN WITH DISINFECTANT AFTER EVERY CLASS

Disinfectant and related supplies are available to all employees at their workstations and the following location(s):

IN EACH CLASSROOM / STUDIO, BATHROOM, DRESSING ROOM, ENTRY TO BUILDING, & WORKSTATIONS.

Hand sanitizer effective against COVID-19 is available to all employees at workstations and the following location(s):

IN EACH CLASSROOM / STUDIO, BATHROOM, DRESSING ROOM, ENTRY TO BUILDING, & WORKSTATIONS.

There are no employees that travel in and out of Routt County to perform work.

If there are employees that travel in and out of Routt County to perform work, the following measures have been implemented in order to reduce that travel and therefore reduce the potential spread of COVID-19:

X Copies of this Protocol have been distributed to all employees.

MEASURES TO PREVENT CROWDS FROM GATHERING:

X Limit the number of customers in the facility at any one time to 9 which allows for customers and employees to easily maintain at least six-foot distance from one another at all practicable times. ONLY PARENTS WITH CHILDREN IN KINDERGARTEN OR YOUNGER ARE PERMITTED IN THE BUILDING LOBBY FOR DROP OFF AND PICK UP ONLY.

X Post an employee at the door to ensure that the maximum number of customers in the facility set forth above is not exceeded.

X Placing per-person limits on goods that are selling out quickly to reduce crowds and lines. Explain: WITH OUR LOBBY IS CLOSED, ITEMS FOR PURCHASE MUST BE ORDERED VIA EMAIL.

Please List Any Additional Measures: ALL CLASSES ARE OFFERED ON VIRTUAL PLATFORM, STAGGERED CLASS TIMES TO LIMIT GATHERING OUTDOORS OR INDOORS

MEASURES TO KEEP PEOPLE AT LEAST SIX FEET APART:

X Placing tape or other markings at least six feet apart in customer line areas inside the store and on sidewalks to public entrances with signs directing customers to use the markings to maintain distance.

X Separate order areas from delivery areas to prevent customers from gathering.

X All employees have been instructed to maintain at least six feet distance from customers and from each other, except employees may momentarily come closer when necessary to accept payment, deliver goods or services, or as otherwise necessary.

MEASURES TO PREVENT UNNECESSARY CONTACT:

X Preventing people from self-serving any items that are food-related.

Bulk-item food bins are not available for customer self-service use.

Contactless payment systems have been provided or, if not feasible, sanitizing payment systems regularly.
